Nick Jackson studied architecture at the University of Cambridge, joining EPA in 1989 and was appointed Director in 1997.

After working in London on a number of projects including Chiswick Park, Pembroke College and Stockley Park, Nick became involved in work in Malaysia, and set up the office in Kuala Lumpur for the practice between 1994 and 1998, where the practice completed an award winning residential development, Damai Suria in Kuala Lumpur.

On returning to London in 1998 he led the team for the refurbishment project at Mandarin Oriental, and the Mandarin Spa. Following that Nick headed up the team for the award winning office building 30 Finsbury Square, which was shortlisted for the Stirling Prize in 2003 and also won awards from the RIBA, American Institute of Architects, British Council for Offices and British Construction Industry.

Recently he has been responsible for the recently completed 5 Aldermanbury Square, a new 19 storey commercial building in the City of London. He is also currently responsible for a new mixed use development at New Bond Street, as well as proposals for a new Spa at Four Seasons Hotel, Park Lane. Nick also continues to develop the Practice's profile in Asia, where we have live projects in Malaysia and Vietnam, and makes regular trips to support work in the region.

Nick has taught in various Diploma Studios and Undergraduate Studios and has been an external examiner at Kingston University since 2005.
