Brendan studied Architecture at Kingston University and London Metropolitan University. He was promoted to Associate in 2014 following seven years architectural experience with Eric Parry Architects.

Brendan has worked on a number of the practice's schemes, including the design and construction of the office building at 23 Savile Row. This included working with the artist Joel Shapiro and the integration of the artwork into the building fabric.

He was responsible for the successful delivery of the Hauser & Wirth Gallery in Mayfair. The project consisted of an extensive new Gallery and Office space which received over 4,000 people on its opening night at the 2010 Freeze art fair.

At the London 2012 Athletes Village in Stratford, Brendan was a key member of the team for our residential apartment block which was delivered prior to the Games. The project's brief, programme and complexity proved to be a challenging and successful experience.

He is currently responsible for the delivery of the £28m new build residential project of Vicarage Gate House. The project consists of the design and realisation of a new luxury apartment building, including a new two storey basement. A unique opportunity in the heart of Kensington.
