Jonathan Schoening studied architecture at the Mackintosh School of Architecture from 1992 to 1998. He joined the Eric Parry Architects in spring 2011 and was appointed Associate in 2017.

Before joining the practice, Jonathan was Associate at Paul McAnery Architects for 3 years, where he primarily worked on exclusive private residential projects in West London.

Prior to this Jonathan worked 4 years at ESA Architecture and Design where he realised a broad range of projects in the role of Project Architect. This included an extension to a community centre in Whitechapel, a new built apartment building in Hackney, an office refurbishment in Westminster and a shopping centre refurbishment in Worcester.

Jonathan started his architectural career in the UK in the autumn 2000 at Harper Mackay Architects in London as an Architectural Assistant, where he was instrumental in the completion of a new-built office development in the City of London.

After completing his Diploma course at the Mackintosh School of Architecture in Glasgow in 1998, Jonathan gathered a broad range of experience working as a freelance and self-employed Media and Architectural Designer in Berlin, Germany. Notable project involvement includes the Bertelmann Pavilion for the EXPO 2000 in Hanover with TRIAD Berlin, and extensive work documenting the restoration of historical monuments in Berlin with a local restoration firm.

Jonathan is a registered Architect in both the UK (ARB) and Germany (Architektenkammer Berlin).
