Ros studied at Cambridge University and the University of East London, and joined the practice in 1999. She was appointed as an Associate in 2010.

Ros is currently working as project architect for the interior fit out of new and renovated buildings in Regent Street, London to provide high quality residential accommodation for the Crown Estate for sale and rent.

Prior to this Ros was project architect for the interior design of new accommodation for the Leathersellers, a livery company who are relocating from their existing premises in St Helens Place, Bishopsgate, to a new building designed by EPA also in St Helen's Place. The design includes a new dining hall, court and reception rooms and a library. The interior design is due to be implemented in 2014 on completion of the new building.

Ros was project architect for the interior design of a new Spa for the Four Seasons Hotel in central London which is housed in a new rooftop extension also designed by EPA. The work included sourcing and specifying all the furniture, fixtures and fittings for use in the Spa.

Before joining EPA, Ros worked for Pringle Richards Sharratt and then in Malaysia from 1994 to 1998. In Malaysia, Ros spent some time working for C'Arch Architecture and Design on a number of private residential projects and a light industrial facility.

She then worked mostly for SIAB AB, a large part Swedish owned construction Management company, on a hotel and office complex in the centre of Kuala Lumpur. Her role was as a site-based architectural coordinator, working with project managers from Sweden.
