Sofia studied architecture at Kingston University and joined Eric Parry Architects in 2006. In 2017 she was appointed Associate.

Sofia is currently working on the new interior and extension of a duplex apartment on Eaton Square in Belgravia Conservation Area for a private client. She is also involved in larger residential developments.

Sofia developed and worked on the interior design of the new Spa at the top of the Four Seasons Hotel in central London, which is housed in a new rooftop extension also designed by Eric Parry Architects. The work also included sourcing and specifying all the furniture, fixtures and fittings for use in the Spa.

Building on the experience gained in interiors Sofia was responsible for the interiors concept for a residential project in Qatar for Msheireb Properties, part of the wider redevelopment of the centre of Doha, and a private residential refurbishment on Kensington Palace Gardens.

In her time at Eric Parry Architects Sofia has worked on an office building planning application at 120 Fenchurch Street as well as proposals for the redevelopment of the Selfridge Hotel.

Sofia has also worked on a number of the practice's competitions, including proposals for the redevelopment of Sherborne House Hotel in Dorset and the winning scheme for the redevelopment masterplan of the Hotel Suvretta House in St Moritz, Switzerland.

Before joining the practice, Sofia worked on a 5-storey residential building in West London for Russell Jones Limited, where she also worked on the refurbishment of several private residences in London. Sofia has also worked in Portugal on a number of private residences.
